

## Code of Conduct / Set of Rules for Senior Players

*Dunnington Cricket Club* is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members.

*Dunnington Cricket Club* believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents, carers or guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Club chairman, Vice Chairman or Club Welfare Officer as appropriate.

As a member of Dunnington Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion. The club has adopted the ECB Equity policy and the ECB Safe Hands policy. All members must comply with these policies.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Senior players should be at the match venue at least one hour before start time. (30 minutes for mid week matches)
- You must inform your Captain, Vice Captain as soon as possible if you are unavailable for a match
