

Changing Room Policy for Dunnington Cricket Club

- Adults must not change/shower at the same time as children for Junior Games.
- If children play for Open Age teams, they, and their parents, must be informed of the club's policy on changing arrangements.
- If adults and children need to share a changing facility for open age cricket, the club must have consent from parents that their child(ren) can share a changing room with adults in the club. This consent can be granted on the signing on form.
- Adults should try to change at separate times to children during matches, for example when children are padding up.
- Mixed gender teams must have access to separate male and female changing areas.
- If children are uncomfortable changing or showering at the club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so. Suggest instead that they may change and shower at home.
- Mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms if U18's are present.

The CWO must be informed of any breach of this policy.
